Purpose:

To assure that all hand tools are kept in good working and a safe

condition.

Scope:

The following guidelines will be used for inspection and maintenance of the

district hand tools.

Procedure:

1. All hand tools will be checked for the following conditions:

- Straightness and strength of handles
- Smoothness of handles (splintering)
- Sharpness of cutting edges
- Tightness of head to handle
- Any defect or condition which will hamper the use and/or safety of the tool and the user
- 2. This check shall be made before and after each use and at least once a week during regular apparatus and inventory checks.
- 3. Any minor repairs needed will be the responsibility of the on-duty crew to see that such repairs are made.
- 4. Any tool found to be beyond repair, or in an unsafe condition, will be brought to the attention of the company officer.
- 5. Sharpening will be done with a file and in a vise if possible. Eye protection and gloves will be worn.
- All tools will be marked with SCO. 6.
