Purpose: To meet state requirements for overfill and spill protection for

storage tanks.

Scope: It is the responsibility of the station captain to assure this SOP is adhered to.

Procedure:

At the time of delivery, the following shall be performed to prevent filling the tanks past ninety-five percent (95%) capacity and to prevent fuel spillage. Refer to *Tank Chart*, attached Form 1.

- 1. Stick the tank(s) to be filled to assure the amount of fuel being delivered will not fill the tank(s) above 95% capacity. A reading of 45 inches on the stick is equivalent to 95% of capacity.
- 2. Record the date and time of fuel delivery.
- 3. Record the amount of fuel delivered to each tank.
- 4. Witness that, at the end of fuel delivery, the disconnecting of fill hose will not cause a spill or release of fuel.
- 5. Fuel fill areas shall be locked after filling.
- 6. Signature of station captain.

A Fuel Delivery Log, attached Form 2, shall be used for recording the above information.
