Purpose: To meet state requirements for monitoring hazardous

materials waste storage areas and to mitigate recordable

releases of hazardous materials/wastes

Scope:

It is the responsibility of the station captain to assure this SOP is adhered to.

Procedure:

1. Each Sunday, station maintenance day, the hazardous materials/waste storage areas shall be inspected for spillage and leakage. Upon completion of inspection, the inspection log shall be filled in. The station captain shall sign as "safety manager". See attached Weekly Safety Inspection Form.

Note: Weekly inspection forms shall be kept for 5 years in the Facility Inspection Binder located in the Captains office.

- 2. The Oil and Antifreeze waste containers shall have a *Hazardous Waste Label* on them with all relevant information filled out. The Accumulation Start Date shall be filled out when the containers reach half full. After 90 days from the Accumulation Start Date, they shall be empted. *All records shall be kept for 5 years in the Fuel Delivery Binder located in the Admin office.*
- 3. The Oil Filter collection container shall have a *Hazardous Waste Label or a Waste Hauler Label* on it with all relevant information filled out. The Accumulation Start Date shall be filled out after the first filter is placed into the container. The container shall be emptied One Year from the Accumulation Start Date. *All records shall be kept for 3 years in the Fuel Delivery Binder located in the Admin office.*Note: *All filters shall drain for a minimum of 24 hrs before being placed into the container.*
