In accordance with the Santa Cruz County Fire Agencies protocol for the purpose of uniform procedures, the following numbering guide will be used when assigning radio identifiers to all district vehicles and personnel.

Officer's 2500 to 2509 series

## **Vehicles:**

Type I Engines	E-2510 to E-2519 series
Type III Engines	E-2530 to E-2539 series (36 to 39 series all-wheel drive)
Water Tenders	WT-2550 to WT-2559 series
Rescue/Support/Haz Mat/Utility	2560 to 2569 series (preface # with appropriate letter)
Rescue Transport	R-2566 to R-2569 series
Prevention	P-2580 to P-2589 series (pertains to personnel and vehicles)
Unit (nondescript)	U-2590 to U-2599 series (sedans and pickups)

B = Battalion (used in reference to duty chief)  
 C = Chief  
 E = Engine  
 HM = Haz Mat  
 R = Rescue

S = Support  
 T = Truck  
 U = Utility or Unit  
 WT = Water Tender  
 M = Medic
